Guidelines: these pages will provide you with basic guidelines that you can use for creating a history of your life.

Combine questions if you wish and skip those that don't seem to apply. Ignore questions that you cannot or choose not to answer.

- 1) If you are new to the community, "We welcome you." We want to get to know and include you.
- 2) If your family has already put information in Volume 1, please add the next 35 yrs. and put in Page no's of first volume if possible.
- 3) If you have parents, grandparents, etc. who lived in the Goodsoil area please include their history.
- 4) No matter how many years you have lived here, we want to hear from you. Preserve your history, your stories, community events, your family memories or funny stories.
- 5) Encourage others. If you know someone who used to live here please let them know we would like to hear from them.

General Information - What you may want to include:

1. Where and when you were born, siblings, interesting stories.
2. Where, when, how, and why you came to Goodsoil.
3. Childhood memories, ie; Childhood illnesses and how they were treated.
4. Where you went to school, how you got there, school discipline and stories.
5. When you left, other schooling (if any) and where you lived and occupation.
6. Earlier home life; lights, heating, water, when you got indoor plumbing, T.V., music, travel, etc
7. What you did for entertainment, family traditions.
8. What you remember about the war years, dirty 30, 40,-----2014, horse/ buggy days, first automobile, etc.
9. What values and principles do you consider most important influences in your life.
10. Advice to future generation.

- 1) You may choose to only answer the questions and let the committee take your information and write a short history which would be subject to your approval. Or, you may write your history yourself with editing done by the committee.
- 2) Please attach a copy of a family picture with all names included. Please indicate whether the picture needs to be returned.
- 3) Please consider contributing any pictures that are both unique and important to the history of Goodsoil and district. These pictures could show the results of the power of nature (eg: tornadoes, floods, fires), special community events, interesting or unusual occurrences, former residents, and any other pictures that capture the life and events of Goodsoil.
